In a 25-year career serving Land Aruba Mr. Andy Lee held several positions in the civil service and in politics of Aruba. Mr. Lee is currently counselor to the Prime Minister of Aruba. Prior to this position he represented Aruba as Minister Plenipotentiary in Washington, DC. He was the Director of the Department of Foreign Affairs of Aruba and served also

as the Director of the Central Bureau of Statistics of Aruba.
