Ieteke Witteveen, anthropologist and cultural heritage expert, has been working since 1989 in Curaçao and the Caribbean region. Previously she worked for grass roots organizations in Colombia, Venezuela and the Netherlands. From 2001 to September 2011 she was director of the National Archaeological and Anthropological Memory Management (NAAM). From 2012-2014 she worked at the Colombian consulate in social and cultural issues. Actually she is member of an expert working group to develop the Historical Canon of Curaçao. She is the president of the Foundation Culture and Development (1995) and the founder and chairman of the Human Rights Caribbean foundation in Curaçao that was founded in 2018 in view of the recent refugee issue.
