
Migration on Sint Maarten





Sint Maarten in brief






Sint Maarten has a land area of **37 km2.** The total population **40.614** (2018)

Historically there have been various migration waves to Sint Maarten










Migration in Sint Maarten






- Increased after passing of hurricanes in mid-90's (Louis 1995, Jose, Lenny 1999)
- Growth of cruise and hotel industry
- Construction boom in 2000's: (PJIA, A.C. Wathey Cruise Port, Blue Mall, various hotels etc.)
- After hurricanes Irma and Maria (2017)
- Projected change in natural increase will decrease in future

Population dynamics

- 91 recognized nationalities from 118 different countries of birth
- 30% of population born on Sint Maarten
- 63.7% have Dutch nationality
- Main nationalities:
 - Haitian (6.7%)
 - Dom. Rep. (5.7%)
 - Jamaican (5.4%)
 - Guyanese (3.8%)
 - Dominican(2.9%)



- Environmental vulnerability e.g. natural disasters hurricane and earthquakes
- Economic crisis

- Tourism boom in 90's
- Hurricanes '95 (Luis),
 2017 (Irma and Maria):
- Legal criteria: immigration and labour laws
- family and friends already on the island
