Rose Mary Allen (PhD) is a cultural anthropologist and a visiting lecturer at the University of Curaçao (UoC). She has published, co-published and edited several books and articles on the cultural and social history of the Dutch Caribbean islands with special attention on cultural heritage, gender, migration and diaspora, and cultural diversity. In 2011, she won the Curaçao's Boeli van Leeuwen Prize for her work. In 2015, she received the Knight in the Netherlands Order of Orange-Nassau and has also been awarded the 2015 Cola Debrot Prize, Curaçao's most prestigious national award in the area of culture, art and science. At the moment she is a Caribbean postgraduate research partner in the NWO/KITLV project *Traveling Caribbean heritage*, and also the Caribbean research partner in the NWO project *Cultural Practices of Citizenship under Conditions of Fragmented Sovereignty: Gendered and sexual citizenship in Curaçao and Bonaire*, University of Amsterdam and University of Curaçao. She is setting up the department of Cultural Studies at the (UoC).
